1 WHEREAS, Family and friends will long cherish their memories
2 of Ina Mae Hardin Allen of McGregor, who passed away on April 19,
3 2011, at the age of 92; and

4 WHEREAS, Born in Jarrell on February 28, 1919, to Joe and
5 Mattie Hardin, the former Ina Mae Hardin was a descendant of the
6 Hardin and Pickens pioneer families who moved to Texas from
7 Tennessee in the 1830s; a self-sufficient and independent woman,
8 she grew up during the Great Depression, an experience that
9 fostered in her a respect for hard work, frugality, and a sense of
10 social responsibility; and

11 WHEREAS, Ina Mae Hardin wed James Allen on August 13, 1938, in
12 Gatesville, and the couple enjoyed a rewarding marriage of 62
13 years, until his death on February 22, 2001; deeply devoted to her
14 family, she was blessed with two children, Jimmy and Judy, as well
15 as five grandchildren and four great-grandchildren; and

16 WHEREAS, Mrs. Allen lived in the McGregor and Oglesby area
17 for most of her life; a valued member of her community, she
18 worshipped at the College Avenue Baptist Church; she enjoyed
19 cooking for her family and traveling, as well as crochet and
20 embroidery; and

21 WHEREAS, A beloved mother, grandmother, and
22 great-grandmother, Ina Mae Allen lived a caring and purposeful
23 life, and those who shared in the warmth of her affection will
24 forever hold her close to their hearts; now, therefore, be it
