2 death of Ross S. Tennison of Waco on April 13, 2011, at the age of
3 80; and

4 WHEREAS, Ross Tennison was born in West on September 6, 1930,
5 to Charlie and Mary Tennison; he attended school in West before
6 answering his nation's call to duty during World War II by enlisting
7 in the U.S. Marine Corps; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Tennison wed the former Daisy Dee Sisk on
9 November 11, 1948, and they shared 53 rewarding years together,
10 until her passing on March 22, 2002; they were blessed with 3
11 daughters, Edna, Doiline, and Linda, as well as 9 grandchildren, 10
12 great-grandchildren, and 4 great-great-grandchildren; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Tennison worked with the Union Pacific Railroad
14 until 1970, when he retired due to an injury; he was a Master Mason
15 with the Grand Lodge of Texas and Fort Worth Lodge No. 148, as well
16 as a member of Shriners International; in his free time he enjoyed
17 traveling and riding horses; and

18 WHEREAS, While the death of Ross Tennison brings great
19 sadness to his family and friends, he leaves behind a legacy that
20 will long be treasured by all those who held him dear; now,
