1 WHEREAS, After four years of dedicated service, John
2 Trischitti III is stepping down as assistant director of the Riter
3 C. Hulsey Public Library in Terrell in May 2011 to accept a new
4 opportunity; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Trischitti began his affiliation with the
6 library in 2006 when he was elected to the Friends of the Library
7 board; he later served that group as president, and in 2007, he
8 joined the library's staff as assistant director; he is known for
9 his enthusiasm, humor, and can-do approach, as well as for his
10 excellent theatrical skills at story time; particularly
11 knowledgeable about children's literature, he has been a member of
12 the Texas Library Association's Bluebonnet Award selection
13 committee and was instrumental in procuring a Texas Reads grant for
14 the summer reading program from the Texas State Library and
15 Archives Commission; and

16 WHEREAS, This native Texan grew up in Lubbock and graduated
17 from Wayland Baptist University with a double major in English
18 literature and journalism; he worked for a number of community
19 newspapers, on a ranch in Wyoming, and with a grocery store chain
20 before joining the Terrell library; with a recently earned master's
21 degree in library science from the University of North Texas in
22 hand, he is leaving to begin a new job as the library director for
23 Midland County; and

24 WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, Mr. Trischitti is supported

1 by his wife, Diana, and the couple are the proud parents of two
2 children, Jay and Olivia; and

3 WHEREAS, John Trischitti's dedication and professionalism
4 have helped the people of Terrell to further enjoy a treasured
5 community resource, and he may take justifiable pride in the
6 important role he has played in keeping Terrell reading; now,
7 therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas
9 Legislature hereby honor John Trischitti III for his service as the
10 assistant director of the Riter C. Hulsey Public Library and extend
11 to him sincere best wishes for success in his new position; and, be
