1           WHEREAS, Mayra Mendez of Edinburg was selected to participate  
2 in the 2011 Moreno/Rangel Legislative Leadership Program, and  
3 during the 82nd Legislative Session she has ably served her fellow  
4 Texans as an aide in the office of State Representative Lon Burnam;

22 office, while acquiring knowledge of issues facing citizens of the  
23 Lone Star State; she has performed her duties as a legislative aide
