1 WHEREAS, The friends and family of U.S. Army Sergeant Mario 2 M. Rodriguez, Jr., of Smithville suffered an immeasurable loss with 3 the death of this valiant soldier on June 11, 2010, at the age of 24; 4 and

9 WHEREAS, Mario Rodriguez grew up in Smithville and attended Smithville High School, where he was a linebacker on the football 10 11 team and demonstrated natural leadership ability; in 2003, he 12 enlisted with the Texas National Guard, and he served his first tour of duty in Kosovo; he was deployed to Iraq in 2007 and was promoted 13 14 to sergeant shortly before his deployment to Afghanistan; his exemplary actions were recognized with many decorations, including 15 the Bronze Star, Purple Heart, Army Commendation Medal, and four 16 Army Achievement Medals; and 17

18 WHEREAS, A kind and caring man, Sergeant Rodriguez 19 consistently put the needs of others before his own; he was an 20 outstanding mentor to his comrades, and he was selflessly devoted 21 to his wife, Leslie, and their daughter, Raven; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Rodriguez exemplified the highest ideals of the United States armed forces, and although his passing leaves a void in the lives of his loved ones, they will forever carry
