2 esteemed local businessman, passed away on May 13, 2011, at the age
3 of 61; and

4 WHEREAS, A lifelong resident of Elgin, Lee Dildy was born on
5 September 20, 1949, to Harold and Betty Dildy; he attended The
6 University of Texas and went on to work with his grandfather and
7 father at Joe's Toggery, a men's clothing store on Main Street; he
8 later established his own business, Dildy's Western Wear; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Dildy was dedicated to serving his community;
10 during his 20 years of leadership as a Bastrop County commissioner,
11 he served on numerous committees and played an integral role in
12 bringing the Capital Area Rural Transportation System to the area
13 and served as chair of its board; in addition, he was active in the
14 Kiwanis Club and the Greater Elgin Chamber of Commerce, and he
15 served as an advisory director for the First National Bank of
16 Bastrop; also a valued member of the First Presbyterian Church of
17 Elgin, he contributed to the congregation as an elder and Sunday
18 school teacher; above all else, he was devoted to his wife of 32
19 years, Vivian, and his daughter, Megan; and
