1 WHEREAS, The Lone Star State lost an admired jurist and 2 public servant with the passing of the Honorable Ricardo H. Garcia 3 of Duval County on September 23, 2010, at the age of 79; and

WHEREAS, Born on June 17, 1931, Ricardo Garcia graduated from 4 San Diego High School, where he was voted most likely to succeed; he 5 served his country in the Korean War and went on to earn his 6 bachelor's degree from Texas A&I University; after working for the 7 Corn Products Refining Company and teaching in the San Diego and 8 Edgewood Independent School Districts, he earned a law degree from 9 St. Mary's University School of Law and embarked on a distinguished 10 11 legal career; and

12 WHEREAS, Voters chose Mr. Garcia to serve as the Duval County 13 attorney in 1970, and he was elected as state district judge for the 14 229th Judicial District Court in 1976, remaining in that post for 22 years; following his retirement in 1999, he continued to share his 15 expertise with state courts as a senior visiting judge; 16 in recognition of his dedicated efforts and achievements, the Judge 17 18 Ricardo H. Garcia Juvenile Detention Facility was named in his honor; and 19

20 WHEREAS, This notable Texan was an active member of the 21 Knights of Columbus, holding leadership positions on the local and 22 state councils and on the national board of directors; he also 23 became the first Hispanic supreme officer in the history of the 24 order and served as an assistant to the supreme knight for Latin
