4 history; and

12 accolades for their stellar play; Priscilla Ruiz, Brenda Ledezma,  
13 and Selena Rubio were named to the All-City first team; in the 29-5A

15 as the most outstanding shortstop and Ms. Ledezma as the most  
16 outstanding outfielder; in addition, Ms. Rubio was selected as a  
17 first-team pitcher, Jackie Davalos as the first-team third baseman,  
18 and Janelle Rodriguez as the second-team first baseman, while Kayla  
19 Rodriguez and Sabrina Sanchez received honorable mention awards;

21           WHEREAS, Throughout the season, the Panthers relied on a true  
22 team effort, with valuable contributions also being made by the  
23 other members of the roster: Miranda Beltran, Elizabeth Garza,

1 Martinez, and Marissa Perez; these determined athletes were guided  
2 by head coach Diana Perales Isassi, whose leadership inspired the  
3 players to deliver their maximum effort; and

4 WHEREAS, The achievements realized by the Panthers in 2011  
5 are a source of great pride to their many supporters in the local  
6 community, and their outstanding performance on the diamond is  
7 indeed deserving of special recognition; now, therefore, be it
