16 WHEREAS, A proud, engaged, and accomplished member of the 17 Knights of Columbus, where he served as a Grand Knight for the De 18 Saules Council No. 2595, he was also an honorable member of the El 19 Cid Caravan No. 106 Order of the Alhambra; a dedicated member of the 20 Rotary International, a devoted parishioner of Immaculate 21 Conception Church in Rio Grande City, and an active member of the 22 Starr County Democratic Party; and
