WHEREAS, A life made rich through family, faith, and service
to others drew to a close with the passing of Merline Clack Johnson
on May 9, 2011, at the age of 69; and

WHEREAS, Born in Seguin to Herff and Callie Clack on March 15, 1942, Merline Clack graduated from Ball High School in Seguin in 1960; a year later, she met and married Prince Albert Johnson of Detroit, who was serving in the United States Air Force and was stationed at Randolph Air Force Base; the couple were blessed with four sons, Quinton, Andre, Reginald, and Marcel; and

WHEREAS, After Mr. Johnson's honorable discharge, the family 10 11 relocated to Detroit, where Mrs. Johnson became a licensed 12 practical nurse; she began her nursing career in 1976 at Henry Ford Hospital, where she was on the staff of the general practice 13 14 neurological-neurosurgical patient care unit for 10 years; throughout her tenure at the facility, she was commended for her 15 16 exceptional service, patient care, and professionalism by both her nursing supervisors and the neuroscience clinical instructors; and 17

WHEREAS, In 1986, Mrs. Johnson returned to Texas, moving to San Antonio to be closer to her family and to help care for her aging parents; she was employed in the medical center at Methodist Hospital for 12 years before retiring, though she occasionally worked as a private duty and part-time nurse for the remainder of her life; and

of several different church congregations; she first belonged to 1 2 Unity Baptist Church in Seguin and served as its church secretary; she later joined Third New Hope Baptist Church in Detroit, the 3 4 Resurrection Baptist Church in Schertz, and, most recently, the Bethlehem Baptist Church in Mansfield; her cheerfulness, patience, 5 and kind and gentle nature made her ideally suited to participate in 6 7 the ushers and nurses ministry, and she did so for more than 25 8 years; and

9 WHEREAS, While the death of Merline Johnson has brought great 10 sorrow to her family and friends, she leaves behind a legacy that 11 will long be treasured by all who had the good fortune to know her; 12 now, therefore, be it
