## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Honorable Ruth Jones McClendon, state representative for District 120, has established the McClendon Legislative Scholars Program at The University of Texas at San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, Since 2004, the McClendon Scholars Program, which is also known as the UTSA Legislative Scholars Program, has provided students with the chance to work full-time at the State Capitol during legislative sessions; Representative McClendon worked with Dr. Richard Gambitta, director of the university's Institute for Law and Public Affairs, to create this program, which allows participants to expand their knowledge and gain firsthand experience in Texas politics and government; and

WHEREAS, Representative McClendon has worked closely with UTSA and many donors to develop this prestigious program, which includes a $\$ 10,000$ stipend; for the $82 n d$ Legislative Session, she raised sufficient funds to offer this unique opportunity to 10 students, the largest class of scholars to date; by the end of this session, 26 McClendon Scholars will have successfully completed the program, and a number of its alumni have gone on to pursue careers in public service after graduation; and
