R E S O L U T I O N

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of  
2 Texas, 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, That House Rule 13,  
3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,  
4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to  
5 resolve the differences on House Bill 3726 (preservation and  
6 maintenance of the Alamo by the General Land Office) to consider and  
7 take action on the following matter:

8 House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(1), is suspended to permit the  
9 committee to change text not in disagreement in proposed SECTION 2  
10 of the bill, in added Section 31.453(e), Natural Resources Code, to  
11 read as follows:

12 (e) The land office may enter into an agreement with another  
13 organization for purposes of this subchapter if the land office is  
14 unable to enter into an agreement with the Daughters of the Republic  
15 of Texas as required by Subsection (a) before January 1, 2012. On  
16 the effective date of an agreement entered into with another  
17 organization under this subsection, any reference in this  
18 subchapter to the Daughters of the Republic of Texas means the  
19 organization with which the land office enters into an agreement.

20 Explanation: The change is necessary to allow the General  
21 Land Office to enter into an agreement for the preservation and  
22 maintenance of the Alamo with another organization if a timely  
23 agreement with the Daughters of the Republic of Texas cannot be  
24 reached.
