8 Corporation in 1985; rising through the ranks, he became an area  
9 manager in 2002 and was the operator for Cinco Municipal Utility  
10 District Number One and all of Cinco Ranch and was a director of the  
11 Fort Bend Municipal Utility District Number Two; demonstrating  
12 exceptional leadership and skill, he instituted measures to enhance  
13 public safety and ensure reliable service even during a natural  
14 disaster; he trained many people in the industry through the years  
15 and instilled a devotion to high standards, and he was also involved  
16 in the establishment of the North Fort Bend Water Authority; and

17           WHEREAS, Mr. Sauter was the devoted husband of Nancy Sauter  
18 and proud father of Kelsey and Lindsey Sauter; he spent countless  
19 happy hours riding with his daughters and helping them with their  
20 horses and 4-H animals; a true family man, he cherished close  
21 relationships with his relatives back in Michigan; he enjoyed  
22 playing golf with his friends as well; and

23           WHEREAS, Through his tireless commitment to excellence in the  
24 water industry, John Sauter greatly benefited innumerable Texans,

1 and although he is deeply missed, his contributions will continue  
2 to resonate in his community for years to come; now, therefore, be
