15 intensive care nurse in Stafford and as an education resource
16 specialist at Memorial Hermann Hospital in Houston and presently
17 serves as the senior vice president of GP Industrial Contractors;

20 giving back to the community; Mr. Petry has served as a
21 commissioner and a committee and board member for numerous agencies
22 and organizations, including the Port Arthur Housing Authority, the

2 demonstrated through his work as an instructor at Lamar University

7 scholarship fund-raiser; and
