2 cut short, but all those who shared in the love and friendship of  
3 Karmin Tergerson Brown of Bellmead treasure their memories of this  
4 special young woman, who died on March 9, 2011, at the age of 22; and

5           WHEREAS, The daughter of Richard Brown and Gail Tergerson,  
6 Ms. Brown was born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, on July 6, 1988;  
7 as a little girl, she enjoyed playing with toy wrenches and  
8 screwdrivers while her father worked on cars, and they spent myriad  
9 happy hours riding together on motorcycles and four-wheelers, as  
10 well as in cars; she and her mother shared such traditions as baking  
11 cookies at Christmas, and her adopted father, Terry Tergerson,  
12 provided understanding and guidance, helping her develop her faith;  
13 an avid reader, she also loved to explore bookshops with her  
14 stepmother, Jennifer Brown; her radiant smile brightened the days  
15 of innumerable people; and

16           WHEREAS, Ms. Brown graduated from Axel High School and went  
17 on to study childhood development at McLennan Community College;  
18 already a skilled caregiver, she could calm the most agitated child  
19 with her soft-spoken, compassionate manner; she was an adoring and  
20 motherly big sister, and she was deeply devoted to her fiance, Daryl  
21 Lee "Bam Bam" Farmer, with whom she shared a fulfilling  
22 relationship of five years; and

23           WHEREAS, Although her time with us was far too brief, Karmin  
24 Tergerson Brown brought great joy into the lives of her loved ones,

1 and they will forever carry her close in their hearts; now,  
2 therefore, be it

3         RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas  
4 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Karmin Tergerson  
5 Brown and extend sincere condolences to the members of her family:
