- 1 WHEREAS, Memories of a purposeful life and meaningful
- 2 accomplishments remain to comfort the family and friends of Ian
- 3 Jackson of Colleyville, who passed away on May 16, 2011, at the age
- 4 of 67; and
- 5 WHEREAS, A highly respected athletic trainer, Mr. Jackson was
- 6 himself a long-distance runner, swimmer, big wave rider, skin
- 7 diver, soccer player, yoga adept, and student of classical ballet;
- 8 he pursued, with single-minded determination, excellence in every
- 9 demanding physical activity he undertook, continually seeking the
- 10 keys to superior performance; and
- 11 WHEREAS, In his work as a trainer, Mr. Jackson dedicated
- 12 himself to drawing out the full potential of his athletes'
- 13 physical, mental, and spiritual resources; possessing a strong
- 14 philosophical orientation and unconstrained by conventional
- 15 thinking, he had "a talent," one admirer observed, "for seeing
- 16 common things in uncommon ways"; Mr. Jackson pioneered a breathing
- 17 method called BreathPlay, which his students considered a pathway
- 18 to remarkable power and endurance, as well as a reliable portal to
- 19 the high performance body-mind state known as "the zone"; this
- 20 technique was adopted by cyclists such as Alexei Grewal, a gold
- 21 medal winner at the 1984 Olympic Games, and John Howard, who
- 22 employed it to help him break a land speed record in 1985; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Jackson's physical and metaphysical studies
- 24 drew on the work of a number of teachers, among them Milton

- 1 Erickson, Moshe Feldenkrais, Hans Selye, B. K. S. Iyengar, Joe
- 2 Henderson, Joel Kramer, and Ernst Van Aaken; and
- 3 WHEREAS, For all the knowledge he gained from such figures,
- 4 however, the greatest source of inspiration for Mr. Jackson
- 5 remained his family, to whom he was deeply devoted; he enjoyed a
- 6 loving marriage with his wife, Sabrina, whom he wed on June 18,
- 7 1998, and he took immense pride in his three children, Breanna,
- 8 Whitney, and Josh; he also delighted in his two grandchildren,
- 9 Jackson and Kira, and shared many happy times with them, including
- 10 some memorable camping trips; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Those fortunate enough to have known Ian Jackson
- 12 continue to be enriched by his example of grace and strength, and he
- 13 will forever hold a treasured place in their hearts; now,
