

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Highland Park High School has been named among the  
2 top schools in the nation in the *Washington Post's* High School  
3 Challenge; and

4           WHEREAS, In selecting the winners of its High School  
5 Challenge, the *Washington Post* compiled a list of nearly 2,000  
6 public schools and ranked them according to the number of Advanced  
7 Placement, International Baccalaureate, or Cambridge tests taken  
8 by graduating seniors in the school; Highland Park High, the only  
9 large, comprehensive high school in Texas to receive this  
10 recognition, placed 11th in the state for its students'  
11 participation in advanced placement exams, and it was ranked 35th  
12 in the United States; and

13           WHEREAS, Highland Park High has long enjoyed a reputation for  
14 academic rigor; it has been rated "exemplary" by the Texas  
15 Education Agency every year since the state accountability system  
16 began, and it is designated as a Blue Ribbon School by the U.S.  
17 Department of Education; moreover, it has been frequently named one  
18 of the country's best schools in such publications as *U.S. News and*  
19 *World Report*, *Newsweek*, *Parade*, and the *Wall Street Journal*; and

20           WHEREAS, Under the skilled leadership of principal Walter  
21 Kelly, the faculty and staff at Highland Park High School dedicate  
22 themselves to providing a challenging, well-rounded education for  
23 the HPHS students, and all associated with the school can take  
24 justifiable pride in this most recent accolade; now, therefore, be
