

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, For nearly two decades, nurse practitioner Tim Flynn  
2 has helped to ensure and maintain the good health of the public  
3 officials and state employees who work in the Capitol Complex, and  
4 he has continued this exemplary service through the Regular Session  
5 of the 82nd Texas Legislature; and

6           WHEREAS, Each session, Mr. Flynn works in conjunction with a  
7 doctor of the day, but all year round, during the session and  
8 throughout the interim, he regularly provides expert medical  
9 assistance to the steady stream of visitors to his Capitol office,  
10 often saving patients a time-consuming and expensive visit to the  
11 doctor's office or even the emergency room; and

12           WHEREAS, Mr. Flynn was born in St. Louis, Missouri, and he  
13 earned a bachelor's degree in nursing from The University of Texas  
14 at Austin; he began his tenure as Capitol nurse in 1992, and in 2002  
15 he received his master's degree in nursing from UT with a perfect  
16 4.0 grade point average and earned certification as an advanced  
17 practice nurse, or nurse practitioner, which enabled him to offer a  
18 wider range of care; and

19           WHEREAS, In recognition of his exceptional skill and  
20 dedicated service, Mr. Flynn was honored with the Austin Advanced  
21 Practice Nurses Alliance Award of Excellence in 2007; and

22           WHEREAS, Tim Flynn is universally regarded with respect and  
23 affection for his skill, his compassion, and his cordial, welcoming  
24 manner, and he is indeed deserving of the gratitude and friendship

1 of all who work at the Capitol; now, therefore, be it

2           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 82nd Texas  
3 Legislature hereby honor Tim Flynn for his outstanding service as  
4 Capitol nurse practitioner and extend to him sincere best wishes  
5 for continued success and happiness; and, be it further

6           RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
7 prepared for Mr. Flynn as an expression of high regard by the Texas  
8 House of Representatives.
