- 6 efforts, she was named Conservation Rancher of the Year in 1983; her
- 7 love of the outdoors was further reflected in her hobby of hunting,
- 8 and she pursued birds and other quarry in locations around the

- 11 the course of her life, but she especially loved spending time in
- 12 the company of her grandchildren and cheering on the San Antonio
