6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 1551, Insurance Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 1551.1022 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 1551.1022. PARTICIPATION ELIGIBILITY: CERTAIN
9	POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWS AND GRADUATE STUDENTS. (a) An individual who
10	is not eligible to participate in the group benefits program under
11	Section 1551.101 is eligible to participate in the group benefits
12	program under this section if the individual, at an institution of
13	higher education:
14	(1) holds:
15	(A) a postdoctoral fellowship; or
16	(B) one or more graduate student fellowships
17	awarded to the individual on a competitive basis that, either
18	singly or in combination, are valued at not less than \$10,000 per
19	year; and
20	(2) is currently receiving a stipend from an
21	applicable fellowship.
22	(b) An individual who is eligible to participate in the
23	group benefits program under this section shall pay all
24	contributions required under this chapter for the coverage selected

by the individual, except that an institution of higher education 1 may make contributions for the individual from available funds 2 3 other than money appropriated to the institution from the general 4 revenue fund. 5 (c) An institution of higher education shall determine which individuals are eligible to participate in the group benefits 6 7 program under this section and, at the time of initial eligibility, shall notify each individual of the individual's eligibility to 8

9 participate in the program.

10 (d) An individual who participates in the group benefits 11 program under this section is not considered an employee of an 12 institution of higher education solely as a result of the 13 individual's participation in the program.

14 SECTION 2. Section 1551.151, Insurance Code, is amended to 15 read as follows:

Sec. 1551.151. ENTITLEMENT TO COVERAGE. An individual who is eligible to participate in the group benefits program under Section 1551.101, [<del>or</del>] 1551.102, or 1551.1022 is entitled to secure for a dependent of the individual any group coverages provided under this chapter, as determined by the board of trustees and subject to the exceptions provided by this subchapter.

22 SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 1601, Insurance Code, is 23 amended by adding Section 1601.1021 to read as follows:

24 <u>Sec. 1601.1021. PARTICIPATION ELIGIBILITY: CERTAIN</u> 25 <u>POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWS AND GRADUATE STUDENTS. (a) An individual who</u> 26 <u>is not eligible to participate in the uniform program under Section</u> 27 <u>1601.101 is eligible to participate in the uniform program under</u>

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1	this section if the individual, at an institution in a system:
2	(1) holds:
3	(A) a postdoctoral fellowship; or
4	(B) one or more graduate student fellowships
5	awarded to the individual on a competitive basis that, either
6	singly or in combination, are valued at not less than \$10,000 per
7	year; and
8	(2) is currently receiving a stipend from an
9	applicable fellowship.
10	(b) An individual who is eligible to participate in the
11	uniform program under this section shall pay all contributions
12	required under this chapter for the coverage selected by the
13	individual, except that an institution of higher education may make
14	contributions for the individual from available funds other than
15	money appropriated to the institution from the general revenue
16	fund.
17	(c) An institution of higher education shall determine
18	which individuals are eligible to participate in the uniform
19	program under this section and, at the time of initial eligibility,
20	shall notify each individual of the individual's eligibility to
21	participate in the program.
22	(d) An individual who participates in the uniform program
23	under this section is not considered an employee of an institution
24	of higher education solely as a result of the individual's
25	participation in the program.
26	SECTION 4. Section 1601.107, Insurance Code, is amended to
27	read as follows:

Sec. 1601.107. COVERAGE FOR DEPENDENTS. An individual who is eligible to participate in the uniform program under Section 1601.101, [<del>or</del>] 1601.102, or 1601.1021 is entitled to secure for a dependent of the individual any group coverages provided under this chapter for dependents under rules adopted by the applicable system.

SECTION 5. Effective January 1, 2012, Subsection (d),
Section 1601.101, Insurance Code, is repealed.

9 SECTION 6. (a) The board of trustees of the Employees Retirement System of Texas shall include coverage under Section 10 11 1551.1022, Insurance Code, as added by this Act, in an insurance policy or contract or evidence of coverage delivered, issued for 12 13 delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2012. The board of trustees may include coverage under Section 1551.1022, Insurance 14 15 Code, as added by this Act, in an insurance policy or contract or an 16 evidence of coverage delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2012, if the board of trustees determines that the 17 coverage may reasonably be included. 18

The governing board of The University of Texas System or 19 (b) 20 The Texas A&M University System, as applicable, shall include coverage under Section 1601.1021, Insurance Code, as added by this 21 Act, in an insurance policy or contract or evidence of coverage 22 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 23 24 The governing board of a system may include coverage under 2012. Section 1601.1021, Insurance Code, as added by this Act, in an 25 insurance policy or contract or an evidence of coverage delivered, 26 27 issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2012, if the

1 governing board determines that the coverage may reasonably be 2 included.

3 SECTION 7. Except as otherwise provided by this Act, this 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
