- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6
- SECTION 1. Section 61.0904, Education Code, is amended to 7
- read as follows: 8

- Sec. 61.0904. HIGHER EDUCATION ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM 9
- [REVIEW OF INSTITUTIONAL GROUPINGS]. (a) At least once every 10 10
- years, the board shall conduct a review of the institutional 11
- 12 groupings under the board's <u>higher education</u> accountability
- system, including a review of the criteria for and definitions 13
- assigned to those groupings. 14
- (b) The board shall include within the board's higher 15
- education accountability system any for-profit private 16
- postsecondary educational institutions or for-profit career 17
- schools and colleges in this state that offer degree programs. 18
- Regardless of whether the board is conducting a periodic review of 19
- institutional groupings as required by Subsection (a), the board 20
- shall determine whether to create one or more separate 21
- institutional groupings for entities to which this subsection 22
- 23 applies. In implementing this subsection, the board shall:
- 24 (1) consult with affected private postsecondary

- 1 educational institutions and career schools and colleges regarding
- 2 the imposition of reporting requirements on those entities; and
- 3 (2) adopt rules that clearly define the types and
- 4 amounts of information to be reported to the board.
- 5 <u>(c) In advance of each regular session of the legislature,</u>
- 6 the board shall report to each standing legislative committee with
- 7 primary jurisdiction over higher education regarding any entities
- 8 to which Subsection (b) applies that do not participate in the
- 9 board's accountability system as provided by that subsection.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
