## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the use of restraints in state supported living
3	centers.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 592, Health and Safety Code, is amended
6	by adding Subchapter E to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER E. USE OF RESTRAINTS IN STATE SUPPORTED LIVING CENTERS
8	Sec. 592.101. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "executive
9	commissioner" means the executive commissioner of the Health and
10	Human Services Commission.
11	Sec. 592.102. USE OF RESTRAINTS. (a) The executive
12	commissioner shall adopt rules to ensure that:
13	(1) a mechanical or physical restraint is not
14	administered to a resident of a state supported living center
15	unless the restraint is:
16	(A) necessary to prevent imminent physical
17	injury to the resident or another; and
18	(B) the least restrictive restraint effective to
19	prevent imminent physical injury;
20	(2) the administration of a mechanical or physical
21	restraint to a resident of a state supported living center ends
22	immediately once the imminent risk of physical injury abates; and
23	(3) a mechanical or physical restraint is not
24	administered to a resident of a state supported living center as

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punishment or as part of a behavior plan. 1 (b) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules to 2 prohibit the use of prone and supine holds on a resident of a state 3 4 supported living center except as transitional holds. 5 Sec. 592.103. STANDING ORDERS FOR RESTRAINTS PROHIBITED. (a) A person may not issue a standing order to administer on an 6 7 as-needed basis mechanical or physical restraints to a resident of a state supported living center. 8 9 (b) A person may not administer mechanical or physical restraints to a resident of a state supported living center 10 11 pursuant to a standing order to administer restraints on an 12 as-needed basis. 13 Sec. 592.104. STRAITJACKETS PROHIBITED. A person may not use a straitjacket to restrain a resident of a state supported 14 15 living center. 16 Sec. 592.105. DUTY TO REPORT. A state supported living center shall report to the executive commissioner each incident in 17 18 which a physical or mechanical restraint is administered to a resident of a state supported living center. The report must 19 20 contain information and be in the form required by rules of the executive commissioner. 21 22 Sec. 592.106. CONFLICT WITH OTHER LAW. To the extent of a conflict between this subchapter and Chapter 322, this subchapter 23 24 controls. 25 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2012, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall 26

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adopt rules required under Sections 592.102 and 592.105, Health and

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1 Safety Code, as added by this Act.

2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
