## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the use of restraints in state supported living
3	centers.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 592, Health and Safety Code, is amended
6	by adding Subchapter E to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER E. USE OF RESTRAINTS IN STATE SUPPORTED LIVING CENTERS
8	Sec. 592.101. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "executive
9	commissioner" means the executive commissioner of the Health and
10	Human Services Commission.
11	Sec. 592.102. USE OF RESTRAINTS. (a) The executive
12	<pre>commissioner shall adopt rules to ensure that:</pre>
13	(1) a mechanical or physical restraint is not
14	administered to a resident of a state supported living center
15	unless the restraint is:
16	(A) necessary to prevent imminent physical
17	injury to the resident or another; and
18	(B) the least restrictive restraint effective to
19	prevent imminent physical injury;
20	(2) the administration of a mechanical or physical
21	restraint to a resident of a state supported living center ends
22	immediately once the imminent risk of physical injury abates; and
23	(3) a mechanical or physical restraint is not

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administered to a resident of a state supported living center as

- 1 punishment or as part of a behavior plan.
- 2 (b) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules to
- 3 prohibit the use of prone and supine holds on a resident of a state
- 4 supported living center except as transitional holds.
- 5 Sec. 592.103. STANDING ORDERS FOR RESTRAINTS PROHIBITED.
- 6 (a) A person may not issue a standing order to administer on an
- 7 <u>as-needed basis mechanical or physical restraints to a resident of</u>
- 8 a state supported living center.
- 9 (b) A person may not administer mechanical or physical
- 10 restraints to a resident of a state supported living center
- 11 pursuant to a standing order to administer restraints on an
- 12 as-needed basis.
- Sec. 592.104. STRAITJACKETS PROHIBITED. A person may not
- 14 use a straitjacket to restrain a resident of a state supported
- 15 <u>living center.</u>
- Sec. 592.105. DUTY TO REPORT. A state supported living
- 17 center shall report to the executive commissioner each incident in
- 18 which a physical or mechanical restraint is administered to a
- 19 resident of a state supported living center. The report must
- 20 contain information and be in the form required by rules of the
- 21 <u>executive commissioner</u>.
- Sec. 592.106. CONFLICT WITH OTHER LAW. To the extent of a
- 23 conflict between this subchapter and Chapter 322, this subchapter
- 24 controls.
- 25 SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2012, the executive
- 26 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 27 adopt rules required under Sections 592.102 and 592.105, Health and

- 1 Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
