- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 37.008, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (1-1) to read as follows:
- 8 (1-1) A school district shall provide the parents of a
- 9 student removed to a disciplinary alternative education program
- 10 with written notice of the district's obligation under Subsection
- 11 (1) to provide the student with an opportunity to complete
- 12 <u>coursework required for graduation. The notice must:</u>
- 13 (1) include information regarding all methods
- 14 available for completing the coursework; and
- 15 (2) state that the methods are available at no cost to
- 16 the student.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 18 school year.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
