8	IMPAIRMENTS. (a) To be eligible to be issued a certificate to
9	teach students with visual impairments, a person must:
10	(1) complete either:
11	(A) all course work required for that
12	certification in an approved educator preparation program; or
13	(B) an alternative educator certification
14	program approved for the purpose by the board;
15	(2) perform satisfactorily on each examination
16	prescribed under Section 21.048 for certification to teach students
17	with visual impairments, after completing the course work or
18	program described by Subdivision (1); and
19	(3) satisfy any other requirements prescribed by the
20	board.
21	(b) Subsection (a) does not apply to eligibility for a
22	certificate to teach students with visual impairments, including
23	eligibility for renewal of that certificate, if the application for
24	the initial certificate was submitted on or before September 1,
