1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the designation of segments of State Highway 359, State  
1-9 Highway 16, and State Highway 285 as the Veterans of the Korean War  
1-10 Memorial Highway.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
1-13 is amended by adding Section 225.0341 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 225.0341. VETERANS OF THE KOREAN WAR MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

1-15 (a) The following highways are collectively designated as the  
1-16 Veterans of the Korean War Memorial Highway:

1-17 (1) State Highway 359, between U.S. Highway 83 and  
1-18 State Highway 16;

1-19 (2) State Highway 16 between State Highway 359 and  
1-20 State Highway 285; and

1-21 (3) State Highway 285 between State Highway 16 and the  
1-22 eastern boundary of the city of Falfurrias.

1-23 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-24 (1) design and construct memorial markers indicating  
1-25 the highway number, the designation as the Veterans of the Korean  
1-26 War Memorial Highway, and any other appropriate information; and

1-27 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
1-28 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
