A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to debt issuance authority of and funding for the Cancer
3	Prevention and Research Institute of Texas.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 1232, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 1232.1221 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1232.1221. COMMENCEMENT OF CERTAIN MULTIYEAR
8	CANCER-RELATED PROJECTS. (a) Funds may be distributed to a grant
9	recipient for a multiyear project for which an award is granted by
10	the Cancer Prevention and Research Institute of Texas Oversight
11	Committee as authorized by Section 102.257, Health and Safety Code,
12	after the authority has certified that obligations in an amount
13	sufficient to pay the money needed to fund the project have been
14	authorized for issuance by the authority and approved by the Bond
15	Review Board.
16	(b) After issuing the obligations, the board shall:
17	(1) pay the costs of the issuance and any related bond
18	administrative costs of the authority;

- 19 (2) certify to the Cancer Prevention and Research
- 20 Institute of Texas and to the comptroller that the proceeds from the
- 21 <u>issuance are available; and</u>
- 22 (3) deposit the proceeds into the state treasury to be
- 23 <u>credited to the account of the Cancer Prevention and Research</u>
- 24 <u>Institute of Texas.</u>

- 1 SECTION 2. Subsections (b) and (c), Section 102.201, Health
- 2 and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 3 (b) The cancer prevention and research fund consists of:
- 4 (1) patent, royalty, and license fees and other income
- 5 received under a contract entered into as provided by Section
- 6 102.255;
- 7 (2) appropriations of money to the fund by the
- 8 legislature, except that the appropriated money may not include the
- 9 proceeds from the issuance of bonds authorized by Section 67,
- 10 Article III, Texas Constitution;
- 11 (3) gifts, grants, including grants from the federal
- 12 government, and other donations received for the fund; and
- 13 (4) interest earned on the investment of money in the
- 14 fund.
- 15 (c) The fund may be used only to pay for:
- 16 (1) grants for cancer research and for cancer research
- 17 facilities in this state to realize therapies, protocols, and
- 18 medical procedures for the cure or substantial mitigation of all
- 19 types of cancer in humans;
- 20 (2) the purchase, subject to approval by the
- 21 institute, of laboratory facilities by or on behalf of a state
- 22 agency or grant recipient;
- 23 (3) grants to public or private persons to implement
- 24 the Texas Cancer Plan;
- 25 (4) the operation of the institute; [and]
- 26 (5) grants for cancer prevention and control programs
- 27 in this state to mitigate the incidence of all types of cancer in

- 1 humans; and
- 2 (6) debt service on bonds issued as authorized by
- 3 Section 67, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 4 SECTION 3. Section 102.257, Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 102.257. MULTIYEAR PROJECTS. The oversight committee
- 7 may grant funds for a multiyear project. The oversight committee
- 8 must specify the total amount of [All the] money approved [needed]
- 9 to fund $\underline{\text{the}}$ [$\underline{\textbf{a}}$] multiyear project. The total amount specified is
- 10 considered for purposes of Section 102.253 to have been [must be]
- 11 awarded in the state fiscal year that the project is approved by the
- 12 research and prevention programs committee. The institute shall
- 13 distribute only the money that will be expended during that fiscal
- 14 year. The institute may maintain the remaining money needed in each
- 15 subsequent fiscal year [shall be maintained] in an escrow account
- 16 to be distributed by the institute $\underline{\text{as}}$ the money is needed $[\underline{\text{in}}]$
- 17 subsequent years of the project].
- SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 19 a grant of funds for a multiyear project by the Cancer Prevention
- 20 and Research Institute of Texas Oversight Committee as authorized
- 21 by Section 102.257, Health and Safety Code, as amended by this Act,
- 22 made on or after June 1, 2011. A grant of funds for a multiyear
- 23 project made before that date is governed by the law in effect on
- 24 the date the grant was made, and the former law is continued in
- 25 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
