1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to debt issuance authority of and funding for the Cancer
1-11 Prevention and Research Institute of Texas.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 1232, Government Code, is
1-14 amended by adding Section 1232.1221 to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 1232.1221. COMMENCEMENT OF CERTAIN MULTIYEAR
1-16 CANCER-RELATED PROJECTS. (a) Funds may be distributed to a grant
1-17 recipient for a multiyear project for which an award is granted by
1-18 the Cancer Prevention and Research Institute of Texas Oversight
1-19 Committee as authorized by Section 102.257, Health and Safety Code,
1-20 after the authority has certified that obligations in an amount
1-21 sufficient to pay the money needed to fund the project have been
1-22 authorized for issuance by the authority and approved by the Bond
1-23 Review Board.

1-24 (b) After issuing the obligations, the board shall:

1-25 (1) pay the costs of the issuance and any related bond
1-26 administrative costs of the authority;

1-27 (2) certify to the Cancer Prevention and Research
1-28 Institute of Texas and to the comptroller that the proceeds from the
1-29 issuance are available; and

1-30 (3) deposit the proceeds into the state treasury to be
1-31 credited to the account of the Cancer Prevention and Research
1-32 Institute of Texas.

1-33 SECTION 2. Subsections (b) and (c), Section 102.201, Health
1-34 and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-35 (b) The cancer prevention and research fund consists of:

1-36 (1) patent, royalty, and license fees and other income
1-37 received under a contract entered into as provided by Section
1-38 102.255;

1-39 (2) appropriations of money to the fund by the
1-40 legislature, except that the appropriated money may not include the
1-41 proceeds from the issuance of bonds authorized by Section 67,
1-42 Article III, Texas Constitution;

1-43 (3) gifts, grants, including grants from the federal
1-44 government, and other donations received for the fund; and

1-45 (4) interest earned on the investment of money in the
1-46 fund.

1-47 (c) The fund may be used only to pay for:

1-48 (1) grants for cancer research and for cancer research
1-49 facilities in this state to realize therapies, protocols, and
1-50 medical procedures for the cure or substantial mitigation of all
1-51 types of cancer in humans;

1-52 (2) the purchase, subject to approval by the
1-53 institute, of laboratory facilities by or on behalf of a state
1-54 agency or grant recipient;

1-55 (3) grants to public or private persons to implement
1-56 the Texas Cancer Plan;

1-57 (4) the operation of the institute; ~~and~~

1-58 (5) grants for cancer prevention and control programs
1-59 in this state to mitigate the incidence of all types of cancer in
1-60 humans; and

1-61 (6) debt service on bonds issued as authorized by
1-62 Section 67, Article III, Texas Constitution.
