- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 2175.304, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 8 (e) Notwithstanding Subsections (b) and (c), a university
- 9 system or institution or agency of higher education included within
- 10 the definition of "state agency" under Section 2151.002 may donate
- 11 data processing equipment that is surplus or salvage property to a
- 12 public or private hospital located in a rural county. For purposes
- 13 of this subsection, "rural county" has the meaning assigned by
- 14 <u>Section 487.301.</u>
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
