## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.0216, Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 28.0216. DISTRICT GRADING POLICY. (a) Before each
- 8 school year, a [A] school district shall adopt a grading policy,
- 9 including provisions for the assignment of grades on class
- 10 assignments and examinations and the calculation of cumulative
- 11 averages of grades[, before each school year]. A district grading
- 12 policy:
- 13 (1) must require a [classroom] teacher to assign a
- 14 grade that reflects the student's relative mastery of the subject
- 15 without employing grade inflation or misrepresenting a student's
- 16 deserved grade [an assignment];
- 17 (2) may not require a [classroom] teacher to assign a
- 18 minimum grade [for an assignment] without regard to the student's
- 19 quality of work; and
- 20 (3) may allow a student a reasonable opportunity to
- 21 make up or redo a class assignment or examination for which the
- 22 student received a failing grade.
- 23 (b) A district grading policy shall apply to the assignment
- 24 of a grade for which written notice is required under Section

- 1 28.022(a)(2), in addition to any other grade assigned by the
- 2 district.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 4 school year.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
