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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to an interim study to determine public school facility 3 needs. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 44, Education Code, is 5 amended by adding Section 44.904 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 44.904. INTERIM STUDY REGARDING PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY 7 NEEDS; ADVISORY PANEL. (a) The commissioner shall establish an 8 9 advisory panel to conduct a study of public school facility needs. The advisory panel is composed of six members as follows: 10 11 (1) one member is the state demographer or the state 12 demographer's designee; 13 (2) one member who is the superintendent or chief 14 financial officer of a small school district; (3) one member who is the superintendent or chief 15 16 financial officer of a midsize school district; (4) one member who is the superintendent or chief 17 financial officer of an urban school district; 18 (5) one member who is the superintendent or chief 19 financial officer of a rural school district; and 20 21 (6) one member who is the superintendent or chief financial officer of a fast growth school district. 22 23 (b) Each member of the advisory panel, other than the state demographer or the state demographer's designee, must represent a 24

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1	school district that, as of September 1, 2011, has a wealth per
2	student, as defined by Section 41.001, that is less than the wealth
3	per student of the Austin Independent School District.
4	(c) For purposes of Subsection (a), a fast growth school
5	district is a school district that has an enrollment of more than
6	3,400 students and has had an increase in student enrollment of at
7	least 10 percent over the five school years preceding the 2011-2012
8	school year or a district that has had a net increase in enrollment
9	of at least 5,000 students in any one of the five school years
10	preceding the 2011-2012 school year. The commissioner shall by
11	rule establish criteria for the other district categories specified
12	by Subsection (a).
13	(d) The commissioner shall designate one member of the
14	advisory panel as the presiding officer.
15	(e) This subsection applies only to a school district that,
16	as of September 1, 2011, has a wealth per student, as defined by
17	Section 41.001, that is less than the wealth per student of the
18	Austin Independent School District. The state demographer shall
19	design a survey for requesting that each school district project
20	the facility needs of the district for five consecutive school
21	years, beginning with the 2013-2014 school year, by:
22	(1) identifying the number of:
23	(A) new facilities needed; and
24	(B) potential projects requiring the expansion
25	or renovation of existing facilities; and
26	(2) classifying each item listed in Subdivision (1) by
27	academic level and purpose, including administrative,

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instructional, athletic, or support. 1 2 (f) After the state demographer has designed the survey, the 3 advisory panel shall review the survey to determine whether: 4 (1) the survey is properly designed to obtain the 5 information intended to be obtained; and 6 (2) each school district can reasonably complete the 7 survey. 8 (g) The advisory panel may require the state demographer to make changes to the survey, including providing or requesting 9 additional information. 10 (h) After the advisory panel approves the survey, each 11 12 regional education service center shall: (1) distribute the survey to each school district 13 14 described by Subsection (e) in the service center's region; 15 (2) provide a method for each district to return the survey results to the service center; and 16 17 (3) report to the advisory panel the results collected in response to the survey. 18 (i) Not later than September 1, 2012, the advisory panel 19 shall report the results of the survey and any conclusions the 20 advisory panel draws from the results to the agency, the governor, 21 the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of 22 representatives, and the standing legislative committees with 23 24 primary jurisdiction over public education. 25 (j) In addition to the survey described by Subsection (e), 26 the state demographer shall provide to the advisory panel a projection of student enrollment growth in each school district in 27

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1 this state over the 10-year period beginning with the 2013-2014 2 school year.

3 (k) This section expires September 1, 2013.

4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
