6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 27, Water Code, is amended
7	by adding Section 27.037 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 27.037. RESTRICTION ON CERTAIN COMMERCIAL DISPOSAL
9	WELLS. (a) This section applies only to a commercial disposal well,
10	as defined by the railroad commission, proposed to be located in a
11	county that is located wholly or partly above a
12	hydrocarbon-producing geological formation that underlies all or
13	<pre>part of two counties:</pre>
14	(1) that are adjacent to one another; and
15	(2) each of which has a population of more than 1.4
16	million.
17	(b) A permit issued by the railroad commission for a
18	commercial disposal well, as defined by the railroad commission,

- 19 that authorizes the disposal of oil and gas waste may authorize the
- disposal of the waste only in the Ellenberger formation or a deeper 20

- SECTION 2. Section 27.037, Water Code, as added by this Act, 22
- applies only to a permit application pending before the Railroad 23
- 24 Commission of Texas on or after the effective date of this Act. A

- 1 permit issued before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 2 the law in effect when the permit was issued, and the former law is
- 3 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
