- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the Kristy Appleby
- 5 Act.
- 6 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 71.0021, Family Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) "Dating violence" means an act, other than a defensive
- 9 measure to protect oneself, by an actor [individual] that:
- 10 <u>(1)</u> is <u>committed</u> against <u>a victim:</u>
- 11 (A) [another individual] with whom the actor
- 12 [that person] has or has had a dating relationship; or
- 13 (B) because of the victim's marriage to or dating
- 14 relationship with an individual with whom the actor is or has been
- in a dating relationship or marriage; and
- 16 (2) [that] is intended to result in physical harm,
- 17 bodily injury, assault, or sexual assault or that is a threat that
- 18 reasonably places the victim [individual] in fear of imminent
- 19 physical harm, bodily injury, assault, or sexual assault[, but does
- 20 not include defensive measures to protect oneself].
- SECTION 3. Subsection (b), Section 82.002, Family Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- (b) With regard to family violence under Section 71.004(3),
- 24 an application for a protective order to protect the applicant may

- 1 be filed by:
- 2 <u>(1)</u> an adult member of the dating relationship; or
- 3 (2) an adult member of the marriage, if the victim is
- 4 or was married as described by Section 71.0021(a)(1)(B).
- 5 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act to Sections
- 6 71.0021 and 82.002, Family Code, applies only to an application for
- 7 a protective order that is filed on or after the effective date of
- 8 this Act. An application for a protective order filed before the
- 9 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 10 date the application is filed, and the former law is continued in
- 11 effect for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
