## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to allowing municipally owned utility systems in certain
- 3 cities to fund a program to aid low-income residents in paying their
- 4 bills.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1502.056(a), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) If the revenue of a utility system, park, or swimming
- 9 pool secures the payment of public securities issued or obligations
- 10 incurred under this chapter, each expense of operation and
- 11 maintenance, including all salaries, labor, materials, interest,
- 12 repairs and extensions necessary to provide efficient service, and
- 13 each proper item of expense, is a first lien against that
- 14 revenue. For a municipality with a population of more than one
- 15 million, the first lien against the revenue of a municipally owned
- 16 [electric or gas] utility system that secures the payment of public
- 17 securities issued or obligations incurred under this chapter also
- 18 applies to funding, as a necessary operations expense, for a bill
- 19 payment assistance program for utility system customers who have
- 20 been threatened with disconnection from service for nonpayment of
- 21 bills and who have been determined by the municipality to be
- 22 low-income customers.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
