The municipality by ordinance shall prescribe the 24

information to be included in the application. The governing body 1 2 by ordinance may authorize the establishment or use of a cemetery located inside the boundaries of the municipality if the 3 4 municipality determines and states in the ordinance that the establishment or use of the cemetery does not adversely affect 5 6 public health, safety, and welfare. This subsection applies only 7 to a municipality that: 8 (1) is located in three or more counties; 9 (2) has a population of 18,000 or more; and (3) does not have a cemetery within its boundaries, 10 other than a family cemetery. 11 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
