## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT relating to registration with the Selective Service System of 2 applicants for 3 certain а driver's license or personal 4 identification certificate. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 521.147, Transportation Code, is amended 7 to read as follows: 8 Sec. 521.147. [OPTIONAL] REGISTRATION WITH SELECTIVE SERVICE SYSTEM. (a) After an application for an original, 9 10 renewal, or duplicate driver's license or personal identification certificate is submitted by a male applicant who on the date of the 11 application is at least 18 years of age but younger than 26 years of 12 age, the department shall send in an electronic format to the United 13 States Selective Service System the information from the 14 15 application necessary to register the applicant under the Military Selective Service Act (50 U.S.C. App. Section 451 et seq.). 16 17 (b) An application under this section must give written notice to an applicant that the application also constitutes 18 registration with the United States Selective Service System for 19 persons who are subject to registration and have not previously 20 registered. The notice must be conspicuous on the application and 21 22 "By submitting this application, I am consenting to state: registration with the United States Selective Service System if my 23 24 registration is required by federal law."

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1 (c) The applicant's submission of the application following this notification constitutes the applicant's consent to the 2 sending of the information and the [The department shall develop by 3 a selective service consent statement as a part of the 4 rule application for an original, renewal, or duplicate driver's license 5 or personal identification certificate. The consent statement must 6 7 include a place to indicate consent or declination to register with the United States Selective Service System and must state the 8 9 benefits and penalties associated with consent or declination to register. The department shall present the statement to each 10 11 applicant who is subject to registration with the Selective Service System and record the applicant's response. A response is required 12 13 to complete the application for a license or certificate for such an applicant. The department shall forward to the Selective Service 14 15 System, in an electronic format, only the information necessary for 16 registration of an applicant consenting to] registration.

17 (d) [(b)] In addition to the <u>notification</u> [statement] 18 required by Subsection (b) [(a)], the department may conspicuously 19 post at each location where applications for driver's licenses <u>and</u> 20 <u>personal identification certificates</u> are accepted one or more 21 signs, in English and Spanish, providing the information contained 22 in the <u>notification</u> [statement].

(e) Subsections (a) and (c) do not apply to an applicant
concerning whom the department has previously sent information to
the Selective Service System.

26 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an application for the 27 issuance of a driver's license or personal identification

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certificate submitted on or after the effective date of this Act.
SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
