| 5  | SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 2251, Insurance Code, is            |
| 6  | amended by adding Section 2251.1511 to read as follows:              |
| 7  | Sec. 2251.1511. PRIOR APPROVAL FOR CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL               |
| 8  | PROPERTY INSURANCE RATES. (a) An insurer may not use a rate for      |
| 9  | residential property insurance until the rate and all other          |
| 10 | information required by Section 2251.101 have been filed with the    |
| 11 | department and the rate has been approved by the commissioner if the |
| 12 | insurer, together with any of the insurer's affiliates and           |
| 13 | subsidiaries, as those terms are defined by Section 823.003, issued  |
| 14 | personal property and casualty insurance policies in this state      |
| 15 | that accounted for at least five percent of the total amount of      |
| 16 | premiums collected by insurers for personal property and casualty    |
| 17 | insurance in this state in the calendar year preceding the date the  |
| 18 | filing is required or the rate is otherwise proposed to be used.     |
| 19 | (b) Sections 2251.151(b) and (d) apply to rates filed under          |
| 20 | this section.  |
| 21 | (c) Section 2251.152 does not apply to rates for which prior         |
| 22 | approval is required by this section.                                |
| 23 | SECTION 2. Section 2251.156(a), Insurance Code, is amended           |
| 24 | to read as follows:  |

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(a) If the commissioner disapproves a rate filing under
Section 2251.153(a)(2) or 2251.1511, the commissioner shall issue
an order disapproving the filing in accordance with Section
2251.103(b).

5 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only 6 to rates for residential property insurance delivered, issued for 7 delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2012. Rates for 8 residential property insurance delivered, issued for delivery, or 9 renewed before January 1, 2012, are governed by the law as it 10 existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that 11 law is continued in effect for that purpose.

12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
