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- 2 relating to rules adopted and reporting required under the school
- 3 district college credit program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.009(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) The agency shall coordinate with the Texas Higher
- 8 Education Coordinating Board as necessary in administering this
- 9 section. The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary concerning
- 10 the duties under this section of a school district. The Texas
- 11 Higher Education Coordinating Board may adopt rules as necessary
- 12 concerning the duties under this section of a public institution of
- 13 higher education.
- SECTION 2. Effective September 1, 2011, Section 28.009(c),
- 15 Education Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 16 (c) Each school district shall annually report to the
- 17 agency:
- 18 (1) the number of district students, including career
- 19 and technical students, who have participated in the program [and
- 20 earned college credit]; and
- 21 (2) the [cumulative number of] courses in which
- 22 participating district students [have enrolled and college credit
- 23 hours the students] have earned high school credit under this
- 24 section.

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- 1 SECTION 3. Effective September 1, 2013, Section 28.009(c),
- 2 Education Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 (c) The commissioner and the Texas Higher Education
- 4 Coordinating Board shall share data as necessary to enable school
- 5 districts to comply with this subsection. Each school district
- 6 shall annually report to the agency:
- 7 (1) the number of district students, including career
- 8 and technical students, who have participated in the program and
- 9 earned college credit; and
- 10 (2) the cumulative number of courses in which
- 11 participating district students have enrolled and college credit
- 12 hours the students have earned.
- SECTION 4. Effective September 1, 2013, Section 28.009,
- 14 Education Code, is amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as
- 15 follows:
- 16 <u>(c-1)</u> The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
- 17 collect student course credit data from public institutions of
- 18 higher education as necessary for purposes of Subsection (c).
- 19 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
