3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 691, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 691.0225 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 691.0225. INFORMATIONAL DOCUMENT. The board shall
7	develop a document to inform a person making a gift of a decedent's
8	body or anatomical specimen for purposes of education or research
9	of the risks and benefits associated with donation. The board shall
10	make the document available on the board's Internet website.
11	SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 691.031, Health and
12	Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
13	(a) The board shall adopt rules to ensure that:
14	(1) each body or anatomical specimen received or
15	distributed by the board is properly transported;
16	(2) a label with the statement "CONTENTS DERIVED FROM
17	DONATED HUMAN TISSUE" is affixed to the container in which the body
18	or anatomical specimen is transported; and
19	(3) each person who has control or possession of a body
20	or anatomical specimen:
21	(A) satisfactorily completes the information
22	required on a chain-of-custody form prescribed by the board;
23	(B) maintains a copy of the form for the person's

- 4 SECTION 3. Not later than January 1, 2012, the Anatomical
- 5 Board of the State of Texas shall:
- 6 (1) adopt the rules and form required under Subsection
- 7 (a), Section 691.031, Health and Safety Code, as amended by this
- 8 Act; and
- 9 (2) develop the informational document required under
- 10 Section 691.0225, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
