- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 61.0905 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 61.0905. EVALUATION OF REQUIRED REPORTS. (a) The
- 9 board shall consult with institutions of higher education, members
- 10 of each standing committee of the legislature with primary
- 11 jurisdiction over higher education, the comptroller, the
- 12 Legislative Budget Board, the Texas State Library and Archives
- 13 Commission, the Texas Education Agency, and other interested state
- 14 agencies and stakeholders, to evaluate the necessity of all
- 15 reporting requirements applicable to institutions of higher
- 16 education and create a list of those reports considered necessary.
- 17 (b) Not later than May 1, 2012, the board shall submit the
- 18 <u>list of reports created under Subsection (a) to each standing</u>
- 19 committee of the legislature with primary jurisdiction over higher
- 20 education with recommendations for statutory amendment regarding
- 21 higher education reporting requirements, including any
- 22 recommendations for eliminating duplicative requirements and
- 23 <u>streamlining reporting.</u>
- (c) This section expires September 1, 2013.

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
