- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Article 45.056, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 5 amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 6 (f) The judge of a court that employs a juvenile case
- 7 manager under Subsection (a) or (c) shall supervise the juvenile
- 8 case manager, except that the judge may delegate that duty to
- 9 another officer of the court who is authorized to conduct hearings
- 10 under Title 3, Family Code. The judge may not delegate that duty to
- 11 the clerk of the court.
- 12 SECTION 2. Subsection (f), Article 45.056, Code of Criminal
- 13 Procedure, as added by this Act, applies to the supervision of a
- 14 juvenile case manager employed by a court on or after the effective
- 15 date of this Act, regardless of whether the juvenile case manager
- 16 began that employment before, on, or after the effective date of
- 17 this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
