1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the supervision of certain juvenile case managers.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Article 45.056, Code of Criminal Procedure, is  
1-11 amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

1-12 (f) The judge of a court that employs a juvenile case  
1-13 manager under Subsection (a) or (c) shall supervise the juvenile  
1-14 case manager, except that the judge may delegate that duty to  
1-15 another officer of the court who is authorized to conduct hearings  
1-16 under Title 3, Family Code. The judge may not delegate that duty to  
1-17 the clerk of the court.

1-18 SECTION 2. Subsection (f), Article 45.056, Code of Criminal  
1-19 Procedure, as added by this Act, applies to the supervision of a  
1-20 juvenile case manager employed by a court on or after the effective  
1-21 date of this Act, regardless of whether the juvenile case manager  
1-22 began that employment before, on, or after the effective date of  
1-23 this Act.

1-24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
