## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the registration of voters at a polling place during
- 3 early voting by personal appearance and related procedures.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 12, Election Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 12.007 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 12.007. CERTAIN ELECTION OFFICERS ARE VOTER
- 8 REGISTRARS. An election officer serving a polling place for early
- 9 voting by personal appearance is a deputy voter registrar and has
- 10 the same authority as a regular deputy registrar.
- 11 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 85, Election Code, is
- 12 amended by adding Section 85.0312 to read as follows:
- 13 Sec. 85.0312. REGISTRATION AT POLLING PLACE DURING EARLY
- 14 VOTING. (a) A person who would be eligible to vote in an election
- 15 under Section 11.001, but for the requirement to be a registered
- 16 voter, shall be accepted during early voting by personal appearance
- 17 for voting the ballot for the precinct of the person's residence as
- 18 shown by the identification presented if, on the day the person
- 19 offers to vote, the person:
- 20 <u>(1) submits a voter registration application that</u>
- 21 complies with Section 13.002 to an election officer at the polling
- 22 place; and
- 23 (2) presents as proof of residence any of the
- 24 following documents that display the person's current name and

- 1 current address on the day the person seeks to vote:
- 2 (A) a Texas driver's license, including a
- 3 temporary <u>license</u> or <u>instruction</u> <u>permit</u>, or <u>personal</u>
- 4 identification card issued to the person by the Department of
- 5 Public Safety;
- 6 (B) any other identification issued by a
- 7 government agency containing the person's photograph;
- 8 (C) a utility bill or bank statement addressed to
- 9 the person and dated not earlier than the 30th day before the date
- 10 the person seeks to vote;
- 11 (D) a paycheck issued to the person;
- 12 (E) a government check or government document
- 13 issued to or belonging to the person; or
- 14 <u>(F) a document designated by the secretary of</u>
- 15 state under Subsection (e).
- 16 (b) The election officer shall make a copy of the proof of
- 17 residence submitted under Subsection (a)(2) and attach it to the
- 18 registration application. The election officer shall return the
- 19 original proof of residence to the voter.
- 20 (c) A person voting under this section shall vote the early
- 21 voting ballot that would be provided to a voter voting early by
- 22 mail. The person must place the marked ballot in the official
- 23 <u>carrier envelope</u>, <u>execute the carrier</u> envelope as provided by
- 24 Section 86.013, and deliver the carrier envelope and ballot to the
- 25 election officer before leaving the polling place. A ballot voted
- 26 under this section shall be processed in the same manner as a ballot
- 27 <u>voted early</u> by mail.

- 1 (d) For each registration corresponding to a ballot cast
- 2 under this section, the voter registrar shall review the
- 3 application and copy of the proof of residence and determine
- 4 whether the applicant is eligible for registration as provided by
- 5 Subchapter C, Chapter 13. The registrar shall inform the early
- 6 voting ballot board of a determination made under this subsection.
- 7 A registration approved under this subsection takes effect on the
- 8 date the vote was cast.
- 9 (e) The secretary of state may by rule:
- 10 (1) designate additional documents that a person may
- 11 offer to prove the person's residence to register and vote under
- 12 this section; and
- 13 (2) prescribe procedures to implement this section.
- 14 SECTION 3. Section 86.007, Election Code, is amended by
- 15 adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 16 (h) A ballot voted under Section 85.0312 and delivered to an
- 17 election officer as required by that section is considered timely
- 18 returned.
- 19 SECTION 4. Section 87.041, Election Code, is amended by
- 20 amending Subsections (a) and (d) and adding Subsection (f) to read
- 21 as follows:
- (a) The early voting ballot board shall open each jacket
- 23 envelope for an early voting ballot voted by mail or as provided by
- 24 Section 85.0312 and determine whether to accept the voter's ballot.
- 25 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (f), a [A] ballot shall
- 26 be rejected if any requirement prescribed by Subsection (b) is not
- 27 satisfied. In that case, the board shall indicate the rejection by

- 1 entering "rejected" on the carrier envelope and on the
- 2 corresponding jacket envelope.
- 3 (f) Subsections (b)(3) and (b)(5)-(7) do not apply to a
- 4 voter who votes under Section 85.0312.
- 5 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
