- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 14.022, Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 14.022. ERRONEOUS RETURN OF RENEWAL CERTIFICATE. A
- 8 voter registrar shall determine whether [If the registrar
- 9 determines that] a voter's renewal certificate was returned
- 10 undelivered solely because of postal service error, address
- 11 reclassification, or the registrar's clerical error. If the
- 12 registrar determines that the certificate was returned solely
- 13 <u>because of that error or reclassification</u>, the registrar shall
- 14 delete the voter's name from the suspense list, make any other
- 15 appropriate corrections in the registration records, and deliver
- 16 the certificate to the voter.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 16.032, Election Code, is amended to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 16.032. CANCELLATION FOLLOWING END OF SUSPENSE LIST
- 20 PERIOD. (a) If, on November 30 following the second general
- 21 election for state and county officers that occurs after the date
- 22 the voter's name is entered on the suspense list $\underline{\prime}$ a registered
- 23 voter's name appears on the suspense list, the registrar shall
- 24 cancel the voter's registration unless the name is to be deleted

- 1 from the list under Section 15.023.
- 2 (b) For purposes of Subsection (a), if a voter whose name
- 3 appears on the suspense list is shown to have voted in an election
- 4 and the name is not to be deleted from the list under Section
- 5 15.023, the date on which the voter is considered to have been
- 6 entered on the suspense list is the date of the most recent election
- 7 in which the voter voted.
- 8 SECTION 3. Section 63.0011, Election Code, is amended by
- 9 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 10 <u>(f) The secretary of state shall adopt rules to provide for</u>
- 11 the uniform and auditable processing of a statement of residence
- 12 required under this section.
- SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 14 14.022, Election Code, applies only to a voter registration renewal
- 15 certificate returned undelivered and received by a voter registrar
- 16 on or after the effective date of this Act. A voter registration
- 17 renewal certificate returned undelivered and received by a voter
- 18 registrar before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 19 law in effect when the registrar received the undelivered
- 20 certificate, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 21 purpose.
- 22 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
