1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to reporting individual student performance on a physical
1-11 fitness assessment instrument to the Texas Education Agency.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 38.103, Education Code,
1-14 is amended to read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 38.103. REPORTING OF PHYSICAL FITNESS ~~[SUMMARY]~~
1-16 RESULTS.

1-17 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 38.103, Education Code,
1-18 is amended to read as follows:

1-19 (a) A school district shall provide ~~[compile]~~ the results of
1-20 individual student performance on the physical fitness assessment
1-21 required by this subchapter ~~[and provide summary results,~~
1-22 ~~aggregated by grade level and any other appropriate category~~
1-23 ~~identified by commission rule,~~] to the agency. The ~~[summary]~~
1-24 results may not contain the names of individual students or
1-25 teachers or a student's social security number or date of birth.

1-26 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
1-27 school year.

1-28 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
