1 AN ACT 2 relating to including a personal financial literacy component in 3 public school mathematics instruction. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 28.0021, Education Code, 5 6 is amended to read as follows: 7 (a) The Texas essential knowledge and skills and, as 8 applicable, Section 28.025 shall require instruction in personal financial literacy in: 9 10 (1) mathematics instruction in kindergarten through grade eight; and 11 12 (2) one or more courses required for high school 13 graduation. 14 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 31.0231, Education Code, 15 is amended to read as follows: (a) The commissioner shall adopt a list of: 16 electronic textbooks; and 17 (1)instructional material that conveys information 18 (2) to the student or otherwise contributes to the learning process, 19 including tools, models, and investigative materials designed for 20 21 use as part of the foundation curriculum for: 22 (A) science in kindergarten through grade five; 23 and (B) personal financial literacy in kindergarten 24

## 1 through grade eight.

SECTION 3. For purposes of the textbook review and adoption requirements under Section 31.022, Education Code, the State Board of Education shall review and adopt mathematics textbooks that satisfy the requirements of Section 28.0021, Education Code, as amended by this Act, on the next scheduled review and adoption cycle for mathematics textbooks after the effective date of this Act.

8 SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012 9 school year.

10 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
