A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to an alcohol awareness component of the science
- 3 curriculum used in public schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.002(r), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (r) In adopting the essential knowledge and skills for the
- 8 science [health] curriculum under Subsection (a)(1)(C)
- 9 $[\frac{(a)(2)(B)}{(a)}]$, the State Board of Education shall adopt essential
- 10 knowledge and skills that address the dangers, causes,
- 11 consequences, signs, symptoms, and treatment of binge drinking and
- 12 alcohol poisoning. The agency shall compile a list of
- 13 evidence-based alcohol awareness programs from which a school
- 14 district shall choose a program to use in the district's middle
- 15 school, junior high school, and high school <u>science</u> [health]
- 16 curriculum. In this subsection, "evidence-based alcohol awareness
- 17 program" means a program, practice, or strategy that has been
- 18 proven to effectively prevent or delay alcohol use among students,
- 19 as determined by evaluations that use valid and reliable measures
- 20 and that are published in peer-reviewed journals.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 22 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
