- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 8802.053, Special District Local Laws 5
- Code, is amended by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection 6
- (c-1) to read as follows: 7
- (c) As soon as practicable after the publication of each 8
- 9 federal decennial census, the board shall revise the single-member
- districts as the board considers appropriate to reflect population 10
- 11 changes.

- 12 (c-1) In this subsection, a reference to a highway, street,
- road, avenue, boulevard, or lane means the center line of that 13
- highway, street, road, avenue, boulevard, or lane. When the board 14
- revises the single-member districts [under this subsection], the 15
- 16 board shall place two of the districts wholly within the territory
- described as follows: Beginning at the eastern district boundary 17
- and the Colorado River, then south along the eastern district 18
- 19 boundary to the intersection of Interstate Highway 35 and Slaughter
- Lane; then west along Slaughter Lane to the district boundary, then 20
- north along the district boundary to the Colorado River, then east 21
- along the Colorado River following the district boundary to the 22
- 23 point of the beginning
- 24 (1) entirely within the boundaries

- 1 Austin, as those boundaries exist at that time; or
- 2 [(2) within the boundaries of the city of Austin, as
- 3 those boundaries exist at that time, but also including
- 4 unincorporated areas or other municipalities that are surrounded
- 5 wholly or partly by the boundaries of the city of Austin if the
- 6 areas or municipalities are noncontiguous to the territory of any
- 7 other single-member district].
- 8 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 8802, Special District
- 9 Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 8802.054 to read as
- 10 follows:
- 11 Sec. 8802.054. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAW. Section
- 12 36.059(b), Water Code, does not apply to the district.
- 13 SECTION 3. Sections 8802.051(b) and 8802.053(d), Special
- 14 District Local Laws Code, are repealed.
- 15 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 16 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 17 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 18 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 19 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 20 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 21 Government Code.
- (b) The governor has submitted the notice and Act to the
- 23 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
- 24 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 25 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor,
- 26 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives
- 27 within the required time.

- 1 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 2 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 3 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 4 and accomplished.
- 5 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
