1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to changes in the single-member district boundaries of the
1-9 Barton Springs-Edwards Aquifer Conservation District.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 8802.053, Special District Local Laws
1-12 Code, is amended by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection
1-13 (c-1) to read as follows:

1-14 (c) As soon as practicable after the publication of each
1-15 federal decennial census, the board shall revise the single-member
1-16 districts as the board considers appropriate to reflect population
1-17 changes.

1-18 (c-1) In this subsection, a reference to a highway, street,
1-19 road, avenue, boulevard, or lane means the centerline of that
1-20 highway, street, road, avenue, boulevard, or lane. When the board
1-21 revises the single-member districts [under this subsection], the
1-22 board shall place two of the districts wholly within the territory
1-23 described as follows: Beginning at the eastern district boundary
1-24 and the Colorado River, then south along the eastern district
1-25 boundary to the intersection of Interstate Highway 35 and Slaughter
1-26 Lane; then west along Slaughter Lane to the district boundary, then
1-27 north along the district boundary to the Colorado River, then east
1-28 along the Colorado River following the district boundary to the
1-29 point of the beginning

1-30 ~~[(1) entirely within the boundaries of the city of~~
1-31 ~~Austin, as those boundaries exist at that time; or~~

1-32 ~~[(2) within the boundaries of the city of Austin, as~~
1-33 ~~those boundaries exist at that time, but also including~~
1-34 ~~unincorporated areas or other municipalities that are surrounded~~
1-35 ~~wholly or partly by the boundaries of the city of Austin if the~~
1-36 ~~areas or municipalities are noncontiguous to the territory of any~~
1-37 ~~other single-member district].~~

1-38 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 8802, Special District
1-39 Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 8802.054 to read as
1-40 follows:

1-41 Sec. 8802.054. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAW. Section
1-42 36.059(b), Water Code, does not apply to the district.

1-43 SECTION 3. Subsection (b), Section 8802.051, and Subsection
1-44 (d), Section 8802.053, Special District Local Laws Code, are
1-45 repealed.

1-46 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
1-47 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
1-48 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
1-49 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
1-50 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
1-51 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
1-52 Government Code.

1-53 (b) The governor has submitted the notice and Act to the
1-54 Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

1-55 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
1-56 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor,
1-57 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives
1-58 within the required time.

1-59 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
1-60 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
1-61 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
1-62 and accomplished.

1-63 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
