S.B. No. 295

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the definition of emergency services personnel for
- 3 purposes of the enhanced penalty prescribed for an assault
- 4 committed against a person providing emergency services.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 22.01, Penal Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-2) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (b) An offense under Subsection (a)(1) is a Class A
- 10 misdemeanor, except that the offense is a felony of the third degree
- 11 if the offense is committed against:
- 12 (1) a person the actor knows is a public servant while
- 13 the public servant is lawfully discharging an official duty, or in
- 14 retaliation or on account of an exercise of official power or
- 15 performance of an official duty as a public servant;
- 16 (2) a person whose relationship to or association with
- 17 the defendant is described by Section 71.0021(b), 71.003, or
- 18 71.005, Family Code, if:
- 19 (A) it is shown on the trial of the offense that
- 20 the defendant has been previously convicted of an offense under
- 21 this chapter, Chapter 19, or Section 20.03, 20.04, 21.11, or 25.11
- 22 against a person whose relationship to or association with the
- 23 defendant is described by Section 71.0021(b), 71.003, or 71.005,
- 24 Family Code; or

- 1 (B) the offense is committed by intentionally,
- 2 knowingly, or recklessly impeding the normal breathing or
- 3 circulation of the blood of the person by applying pressure to the
- 4 person's throat or neck or by blocking the person's nose or mouth;
- 5 (3) a person who contracts with government to perform
- 6 a service in a facility as defined by Section 1.07(a)(14), Penal
- 7 Code, or Section 51.02(13) or (14), Family Code, or an employee of
- 8 that person:
- 9 (A) while the person or employee is engaged in
- 10 performing a service within the scope of the contract, if the actor
- 11 knows the person or employee is authorized by government to provide
- 12 the service; or
- 13 (B) in retaliation for or on account of the
- 14 person's or employee's performance of a service within the scope of
- 15 the contract;
- 16 (4) a person the actor knows is a security officer
- 17 while the officer is performing a duty as a security officer; [or]
- 18 (5) a person the actor knows is emergency services
- 19 personnel while the person is providing emergency services; or
- 20 (6) a person the actor knows is emergency room
- 21 personnel while the person is providing emergency services.
- 22 (b-2) It is an exception to the application of Subsection
- 23 (b)(6) that:
- 24 <u>(1) the actor is a patient; and</u>
- 25 (2) the emergency room personnel has not received
- 26 training in de-escalation and crisis intervention techniques to
- 27 facilitate interaction with patients, including patients with

- 1 mental impairments, that meets minimum standards established by the
- 2 Department of State Health Services.
- 3 SECTION 2. Subsection (e), Section 22.01, Penal Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (e) In this section:
- 6 (1) "Emergency services personnel" includes
- 7 firefighters, emergency medical services personnel as defined by
- 8 Section 773.003, Health and Safety Code, and other individuals who,
- 9 in the course and scope of employment or as a volunteer, provide
- 10 services for the benefit of the general public during emergency
- 11 situations.
- 12 $\underline{(2)}$ [$\underline{(3)}$] "Security officer" means a commissioned
- 13 security officer as defined by Section 1702.002, Occupations Code,
- 14 or a noncommissioned security officer registered under Section
- 15 1702.221, Occupations Code.
- 16 $\underline{(3)}$ [$\underline{(4)}$] "Sports participant" means a person who
- 17 participates in any official capacity with respect to an
- 18 interscholastic, intercollegiate, or other organized amateur or
- 19 professional athletic competition and includes an athlete,
- 20 referee, umpire, linesman, coach, instructor, administrator, or
- 21 staff member.
- 22 (4) "Emergency room personnel" means a person in a
- 23 hospital emergency department who, in the course and scope of
- 24 employment or as a volunteer, provides services for the benefit of
- 25 the general public during emergency situations.
- 26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

- 8 (b-3) Notwithstanding Subsection (b)(6), an offense under
- 9 Subsection (a)(1) committed against a person described by
- 10 Subsection (b)(6) is a class A misdemeanor if, at the time of the
- 11 offense, the actor was a person with mental illness or intellectual
- 12 disabilities.
